This form of Alocasia has very unique characteristics. Deep green coloration is in contrast to the blackish veins and overall leaf texture is rough and shinny. Some sources also refer to Alocasia Jacklyn as Alocasia Tandurusa but the Jacklyn name reported comes from the person who first found it in Indonesia.
